Exempts such plans from Insurance Code requirements for small employer health benefit plans. Provides legislative approval of corporation business plan for health insurance exchange by repealing provisions of law enacted to require legislative approval. Makes technical corrections. Defines excess revenues as percentage amount of General Fund Revenues available for biennium equal to percentage difference between General Fund revenues available for biennium and General Fund appropriations for preceding biennium minus average two-year percentage change in statewide personal income in six calendar years preceding biennium. Establishes Emergency Reserve Fund. Authorizes, upon making certain findings and with three-fifths majority vote, Legislative Assembly to appropriate moneys in fund. Limits appropriations that may be made from fund during any one biennium. Specifies that if amount in Emergency Fund equals at least 12 percent of General Fund revenues in prior biennium, amount that would be transferred to Emergency Fund shall be returned to taxpayers. Applies to biennia beginning on or after July 1, 2013. Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election.
